This Sunday's Scripture Readings:

Baruch 5:1-9 Baruch looks to the day when God will guide all people, bringing them joy. *Philippians 1:3-6, 8-11* Paul encourages the people of Philippi, and tells them to prepare inwardly for the 'Day of Christ Jesus'.

Luke 3:1-6 John the Baptist's words and actions remind the people of Isaiah's call to repentance.

Prepare the Way of the Lord

John's Gospel message today is timeless. In today's world, we are often overwhelmed by the noise and busyness of our daily lives. We are constantly bombarded with information, distractions, and responsibilities that can pull us away from our spiritual journey. John's call to "prepare the way of the Lord" invites us to pause, reflect, and realign our priorities.
